Helicopter Tours - Helicopter tours of the Volcano are available for \$200.00 per person. The 1-hour flight takes you over areas of the volcano that are inaccessible by foot. Weather permitting; you will fly over the active Pu`u O`o Crater, along the coast to find surface flows and lava tube skylights, and down to the ocean, where lava may be entering the ocean's surface.
